Format: 6 minute quarters, 2-2-2 quarter breaks, 2 two minute timeouts per game

Deck Admittance: All athletes, coaches and officials must check in with the tournament director. Locker rooms will be available for changing, but athletes will be expected to bring belongings into designated seating areas in the stands or on deck so that no two teams are in the locker room at a time.

School Photographer: 1 school photographer will be allowed on deck with proper school assigned credentials. Photographers must exit the pool deck at the conclusion of the game.

Spectator Admittance: Athlete rosters must be submitted to the Grand Haven by Thursday, May 6th or indicate an intention to use the MWPA website for rosters. Each participating athlete

will be allowed 2 spectators per athlete. A check in table will be located at the spectator entrance where each spectator will check in for each game. The stands will be cleared after each game. Parents and fans must exit the building immediately after each game. If you would like to catch up with your athlete after a competition, you may do so outside of the building.

There will be no team/group hospitality areas: For this tournament we would ask that individuals pack their own snacks and drinks. Do not share, food and drink with others, please also adhere to the marked assigned seating areas. Food may be consumed outside, in the foyer area, or in the designated seating area in the south end of the facility.

Facility Rules:

- All Athletes, Coaches, Officials and Spectators must wear a mask. Athletes may remove their mask when participating only. After exiting the pool, athletes will be required to put their mask on again.
- Hand sanitizer will be readily available for participants for this meet, locker rooms will be sanitized before and after the competition by our custodial staff.
